A 4-man team Stableford competition playing in Better Ball pairs with the scores from both pairs aggregated. Pairs will play in four ball groups with a pair from another club. 85% handicap allowance. The expectation is that Clubs will enter teams for all for Winter Series events although the players in each event can be different. The DMVGA Committee reserve the right to curtail the competition to a decided number of holes if delays occur and failing light prevents further play.

Players must be fully paid-up members of DMVGA.

Buggies are allowed. Stover has buggies to hire but Yelverton does not. Players are responsible for booking their own buggy. Use of personal buggies must be approved by the Club in advance.

PRIZES

All players in the first two teams in each event will win e-vouchers. Team scores from the four events will be aggregated. The team with the most points will receive the Winter Series Trophy. No prize money is attached to this trophy.

The Trophy winning team will be invited to the Captain's Invitation event in October 2024.

Entry fee per player for Round 1 (Stover) will be £30. (Home players £13.50). The entry Fee for Round 2 (Yelverton) will be £34 (Home players (£13)). Entry fees include a bacon bap and coffee on arrival, all prizes and entry to the Two's competition. Entry to the competition is via your Club Representative. Entry Fees will not be returned to entrants who withdraw unless there are exceptional circumstances.

Entry Fees for Rounds 3 & 4 have not yet been finalised.

Event 2: Entry Opening Sunday 1st October. Closing Sunday 29th October.
